- 2) The Choir should sit in the front pews on the right hand side of the cathedral ie closest to the organ & piano.
- 3) Gail and Music Group will be in the Sanctuary in front of the piano.
- 4) Thabo, please make sure that the Choir has a copy of this outline and copies of the words we will combine English and N Sotho words in some of the hymns.
- 5) Chapter members, †William Mostert, the Chancellor and Registrar are to be directed to the Vestry to prepare. They will be seated in the sanctuary.
- 6) Please make space in the hall for clergy to vest, and reserve pews for them in the side Chapel.
- 7) Luke & Thabang, please organise two Lay Ministers and make sure they know what they are doing in the service.
